Parking

Every motor vehicle (including motorcycles and mopeds) on University property must have a parking permit. Resident permits are limited, but Fox Valley Technical College students are guaranteed a permit provided they send in their parking application by the deadline (July 31st of each year). Directions to FVTC Spanbauer/FABTECH Education Center from Gruenhagen Conference Center

Take Pearl Ave east to Jackson Street. Turn right onto Jackson (Jackson Street becomes Oregon Street south of the bridge) continue on Oregon Street for about 3 miles. FVTC Spanbauer is on your right at 3601 Oregon Street.

Directions to UW Oshkosh

If traveling NORTH on Hwy 41, get off at the Hwy 21 (Omro) exit (119). Turn right off the ramp. Continue to drive straight, this will change into Congress Ave. You will cross over a bridge. After the bridge, take a right onto HIGH AVE.

If traveling SOUTH on Hwy 41, get off at the Hwy 21 (Omro) exit (119). Turn left off the ramp. Continue to drive straight, this will change into Congress Ave. You will cross over a bridge. After the bridge, take a right onto HIGH AVE.

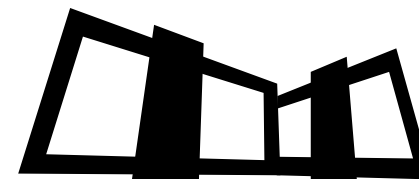

Lodging Information

Our rooms contain two twin beds, dressers, closets, desks, bookshelves, and a microwave/refrigerator unit. All rooms are double occupancy. We will do roommate assignment, unless you and a friend choose to live together, to be marked on contract accordingly. (must be of the same gender)

Rate: Our contract rate for the 2010-2011 academic year has not been finalized. The 2009-2010 Department of Residence Life contract rate is as follows:

DOUBLE ROOM, TWO-SEMESTER CONTRACT: \$3500.

Additional monthly rent charges apply for those students requiring lodging for the summer session.

Contracts entered into with Gruenhagen Conference Center at the beginning of the fall semester are legal and binding throughout the remainder of that academic year. Students beginning in the spring semester must fulfill the entire semester contract.

To secure a lodging space, we require a \$100.00 security deposit per person to cover room and common area damages that may occur (subject to change).

High-speed Internet: In room connection is available for no additional charge. We also offer access to a state of the art computer resource center located on the first floor of the Gruenhagen Conference Center which is open daily from 7:15am – 11:45pm. Wireless (WIFI) access is available in various common areas on the 1st floor and lower level of GCC as well as in all floor lounges.

Year Round Availability: Unlike most of the residence halls, the Gruenhagen Conference Center is open 365 days a year. There are no periods where you must check out because we are closed.

Laundry Facilities: Laundry facilities are available on-site. The current charges are \$1.25 per washer load and \$1.25 per dryer load. We have front load washers, which provide a highly effective method of cleaning clothes.

Front Desk: The front desk offers a variety of services, such as copies, fax machine, U.S. mail drop off, stamps and various sundry items. The desk is open daily from 7 am – midnight. The front desk receptionists are excellent sources of information, don't hesitate to stop by!

Kitchen Facilities: We have a full service kitchen in our lower level that is available for your use. Kitchen utensils, pots and pans also available to be checked out. See us at the front desk to check these items out.

Titan Card: All FVTC students residing in the Gruenhagen Conference Center will be required to purchase an affiliate UW Oshkosh identification card. The cost of this card is \$20.00. The card will be used for various purposes on the UW Oshkosh campus including, but not limited to, dining services, laundry services, access to Oshkosh transit, access to the recreation and wellness center (additional fee) and building security.

Manager on Duty: There is a Manager on Duty whenever the main offices are closed. This person is available to assist our guests with issues that may arise within our facility.

Block meal plans allow you to use as many or as few meals at a time as you need, without restrictions. If you have an inconsistent schedule that calls for you to eat on campus 10 times this week and only once next week, a block plan allows you that flexibility.
